### **MONEY TOURNAMENT**

You must play two matches in the money tournament to collect the LEAGUE payouts..

The tournament is a random blind draw 15 team tournament based on standings with handicap to determine 1-15 team ranking. The top half of the bracket is "B" Division and the bottom half is the "A" Division which allows one "A" and one "B" team into the final four playoff guaranteed. The other two teams come from the loser's bracket.

The teams are ranked 1-15 based on percentage of total games won vs. played in regular season. Actual points scored is the tie breaker. The team having the highest percentage of wins will have home site advantage and is listed on the tournament draw. The home team writes their line down 1<sup>st</sup> and can put players in any order as there are no individual handicaps involved. Players must be listed on the eligible players list to play. Handicap is a team total A1-3 (0)... A4-6 (6)... A7-8 B1-2 (12)... B3-5 (18)... B6-8 (24).

Players must have played 12 games to play in the tournament – no exceptions. If your team is a player short, the score is 16 points for your team and 36 points for the opponents team. If there is a tie in point each team selects one player for a one game playoff for the match win. A coin toss determines the break. The final four team playoff will start with no loses, with a random draw to determine the start of the final matches at a neutral two table site on March 23, 2019.

**A PICTURE MUST BE SENT THE NIGHT OF PLAY TO 218-290-7810 (DO NOT SEND VIA EMAIL OR FACEBOOK MESSENGER) and LEAGUE DUES OF \$56.00 MUST BE SENT IN ALONG WITH THE SCORESHEETS ON TUESDAY NIGHT TO KEEP THE TOURNAMENT ON SCHEDULE. LATE FEES ARE STILL IN EFFECT – CAPTAINS, NOT THE SPONSORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SCORE SHEET AND DUES BEING SENT IN ON TIME.**

Each team has a total games won... ranking that was determined by their finish in the regular season standings. The handicap is marked on the tournament draw from 0-24 points. The point difference between the two teams is subtracted with only one team receiving handicap points in the 4<sup>th</sup> round.

EXAMPLE -- #7 Rudy's has handicap of 18 and #12 Alibi has handicap of 6, so Rudy's will receive a total handicap of 12 points at the start of the 4<sup>th</sup> round.

**The banquet / singles tournament is tentatively scheduled March 2, 2019 (Minnesota Pastime is working on location) menu to be determined the league will put \$200.00 towards the food. It will be small luncheon format. Tournament to begin at 10 a.m. awards will be presented during luncheon break. Entry fee is \$15. Each team is responsible to bring a door prize.**
