THE LEAGUE THIS YEAR IS ORGANIZED INTO 2 DIVISIONS. THERE WILL BE 19 WEEKS OF REGULAR SEASON PLAY IN A & B DIVISIONS WITH THREE PLAYOFF ROUNDS AND CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEARS OFF. THE MONEY TOURNAMENT FORMAT AND LEAGUE PAYOUTS WILL BE REVIEWED BY COMMITTEE FOR IMPROVEMENTS. **LEAGUE FEES PER PLAYER HAS BEEN SET AT \$10.00 PER EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE VOTE \$56 PER MATCH TO THE LEAGUE SECRETARY. THERE WILL BE SANCTION FEES PAID BY THE A LEAGUE TO QUALIFY THE MEN'S LEAGUE FOR PLAY IN THE STATE AND NATIONAL TOURNAMENT (25SEP18) – THIS WILL NOT GRANDFATHER THE EVELETH LEAGUE INTO THESE TOURNAMENTS. THERE WILL BE NO MONEY SET ASIDE FOR THE INTERNATIONAL TOURNAMENT (27SEPT16).** THERE ARE 8 (A) DIVISION AND 7 (B) DIVISION TEAMS IN THE LEAGUE THIS YEAR. FIRST NIGHT OF PLAY WILL BE OCT 9, 2018.

PAYOUTS AND TOURNAMENTS

THE MONEY TOURNAMENT HANDICAPS AND LEAGUE PAYOUTS WILL BE DECIDED BY COMMITTEE. A LIST OF INTERESTED BARS FOR THE END OF THE YEAR BANQUET AND SINGLES TOURNAMENT WILL BE COMPILED EARLY IN THE SEASON BY MINN PASTIME SO THAT THIS CAN BE HELD TWO WEEKS AFTER THE END OF THE SEASON – DURING THE PLAYOFF PART OF THE SEASON. (25SEPT18)

ALL ENTRY FEES WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PLAYERS WHO ARE ATTENDING MOMA **MONEY** OR WORLD POOL CHAMPIONSHIPS.

ALL PAYOUTS WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMITTEE.

THE FINAL FOUR WILL BE PLAYED AT A NEUTRAL LOCATION WITH 2 TABLES.

IF THERE IS A 2ND (SECOND) CHANCE IMPLEMENTED DURING THE MONEY TOURNAMENT. NORMAL PLAY DURING THE TOURNAMENT IS A DOUBLE ELIMINATION. TEAMS THAT PLAY 2 TIMES AND ARE IMMEDIATELY REMOVED FROM THE REMAINDER OF PLAY DURING THE TOURNAMENT WILL BE ENTERED INTO THE 2ND CHANCE TOURNAMENT. WHEN THERE ARE 8 TEAMS AMONGST THE DIVISIONS THAT HAVE BEEN ELIMINATED THEY WILL PLAY IN THE SINGLE ELIMINATION 2ND CHANCE TOURNAMENT. WINNING PLACEMENT IN THE TOURNAMENT WILL RESULT IN ADDITIONAL PAYOUTS. THE AMOUNT WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE (09/10).

PLAYING FEES POLICY

\$56.00 PER WEEK THE COST IS \$10.00 PER PLAYER PER NIGHT. \$10.00 X 8 PLAYERS = \$80.00. \$56.00 IS SENT TO THE LEAGUE SECRETARY, \$24.00 IS THE TABLE COST. THE HOME TEAM CAPTAIN IS RESPONSIBLE FOR SENDING IN THE \$56.00 AND SCORE SHEET MUST STILL BE SENT IN ON TIME OR YOU WILL BE SUBJECT TO THE LATE PENALTY FINES. VALLEY RULES STATE THAT ALL FEES OWED MUST BE PAID TO RECEIVE FURTHER POINTS. SCORE SHEETS MUST BE

MAILED TUESDAY NIGHT AFTER THE MATCH TO KEEP LEAGUE STATS ORGANIZED AND ON SCHEDULE.

SCORE SHEET POLICY

TAKE A PICTURE OF THE SCORE SHEETS AND TEXT IT TO 218-290-7810 TUESDAY NIGHT AFTER THE MATCH. MAIL ALL SCORE SHEETS TO MEN'S POOL SECRETARY, 306 5TH ST SO, VIRGINIA MN 55792. CHECK ENVELOPES TO MAKE SURE THEY ARE CORRECT. (STAMPED-MEN'S POOL SECRETARY) – IF YOU ARE IN VIRGINIA YOU MAY PUT THE SCORESHEET INTO THE MAIL SLOT AT MY HOME – 306 5TH ST S VIRGINIA). MAKE ALL CHECKS PAYABLE TO THE MEN'S IRON RANGE POOL LEAGUE (IRMPL). **PLEASE SEND CHECKS --DON'T SEND CASH! NEITHER THE LEAGUE NOR THE SECRETARY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY CASH THAT IS SENT OR LOST IN THE MAIL. YOU ARE CONSIDERED INCOMPLETE IF WE DO NOT RECEIVE THE PLAYING FEES . IF THEY ARE NOT POSTMARKED BY THURSDAY THEY ARE CONSIDERED LATE AND LATE FEES AND POINT DEDUCTION WILL APPLY. **THE LEAGUE HAS DECIDED TO INACT THE PENALTY FOR LATE SCORESHEETS IF A PICTURE OF THE SCORESHEET IS NOT SENT BY NOON ON WEDNESDAY.** (25SEPT18) THE SECRETARY WILL SEND STATS TO MESABI DAILY NEWS FOR THE SUNDAY PAPER.**

THIS PENALTY WILL APPLY FOR PICTURES SENT BY NOON WEDNESDAY AS WELL AS THE SCORESHEET BEING POSTMARKED BY THURSDAY AFTER POOL.

THE PENALTY FOR LATE SCORE SHEETS IS AS FOLLOWS:

1ST LATE SCORE SHEET: WARNING

2ND LATE SCORE SHEET: 10 POINT DEDUCTION & \$10.00 FINE

3RD LATE SCORE SHEET: 10 POINT DEDUCTION & \$25.00 FINE

THE POINTS ARE DEDUCTED FROM YOUR TEAM TOTAL THE FOLLOWING WEEK. THE MONEY IS DEDUCTED FROM YOUR TEAM TOTAL AT THE END OF THE YEAR. THE SCORE SHEETS MUST TEXTED TO BE IN ON TIME TO HAVE THE FOLLOWING TUESDAY'S AVERAGES COMPLETED AND TO BE IN SUNDAY'S POOL LEAGUE STANDINGS IN THE MESABI DAILY NEWS.

IF I HAVE YOUR PHONE NUMBER OR EMAIL ADDRESS I WILL CONFIRM RECEIPT OF YOUR SCORESHEET AND MONEY WHEN I RECEIVE IT. THIS WILL ELIMINATE ANY QUESTIONS AS TO RECEIPT OF THE MONEY AND WHEN I HAVE RECEIVED IT.

FILL OUT THE SCORE SHEETS COMPLETELY! FULL NAMES OTHERWISE YOUR TEAM WILL NOT GET A SCORE THE SYSTEM WILL NOT TAKE NICKNAMES OR JUST FIRST NAMES. FIRST NIGHT OF PLAY FULL NAME AND NICKNAME I WILL TAKE IT FROM THERE.

FIRST NIGHT- FILL OUT HANDICAP POINTS CORRECTLY. ADD ALL POINT TOTALS. DON'T LOSE VALUABLE POINTS DUE TO ADDITION ERRORS. MAXIMUM OF 48 HANDICAP POINTS PER TEAM PER MATCH, OR 12 POINTS PER PLAYER (3 EACH ROUND) PER NIGHT. IN FORFEITS, THE WINNING TEAM WILL RECEIVE ITS TEAM AVERAGE AND THE NO SHOW TEAM WILL RECEIVE 64 POINTS. INDIVIDUALS SCORE $9 \times 4 = 36$ POINTS WHILE THE FORFEIT PLAYER'S SCORE IS $4 \times 4 = 16$ POINTS.

TEAMS IN A DIVISION THAT HAVE A BYE THAT WEEK WILL RECEIVE 120 POINTS (09/10).

IN THE PLAYER STANDINGS REPORT, INDIVIDUAL AVERAGES ARE ROUNDED OFF TO THE NEXT FULL NUMBER. EXAMPLE: 6.5-7.49 IS A 7, 7.5-8.49 IS AN 8, ETC.

MISCELLANEOUS

ALL AWARD REQUEST FORMS MUST BE FILLED OUT COMPLETELY AND PROPERLY OR NO CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN TO THE PLAYER.

LEAGUE ELIGIBILITY- PLAYERS LIVING IN AN AREA COVERED FROM NORTH TO ORR, SOUTH TO COTTON, WEST TO HIBBING, EAST TO HOYT LAKES. ANYONE NOT PLAYING IN THE LEAGUE IN THE LAST 5 YEARS MUST BE APPROVED BY THE LEAGUE COMMITTEE OR ADMINISTRATOR. 24-HOUR NOTICE IS REQUIRED AND ONLY 2 PLAYERS OUTSIDE THE AREA MAY PLAY PER NIGHT.

LEAGUE PLAY

THE LEAGUE WILL PURCHASE LEAGUE CENTRAL AS THE FORMAT FOR KEEPING TRACK OF ALL PLAYERS STATS. WE WILL TRY TO INCLUDE ALL OTHER POOL LEAGUES IN ORDER TO DIVIDE THE COST BY THE NUMBER OF TEAMS THAT ARE USING THIS FORMAT. (27SEPT16) TO LOG ONTO LEAGUE CENTRAL - WWW.LEAGUE-CENTRAL.COM CHOSE MINNESOTA PASTIME AND THE LEAGUE YOU ARE IN – STATS AND TEAM PLAYERS ARE NOT THERE UNTIL AFTER THEY ARE ENTERED ON THE FIRST NIGHT OF PLAY HOWEVER SCHEDULES ARE THERE. IF YOU HAVE AN EMAIL ADDRESS LINKED TO YOUR NAME YOU CAN LOG INTO YOUR OWN PERSONAL ACCOUNT.

THE PRIVATE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THIS WEBSITE, SUCH AS PLAYER ADDRESSES, PHONE NUMBERS, ETC., WILL NOT BE ABLE TO BE VIEWED BY ANYONE EXCEPT THE WEBSITE USER AND LEAGUE CENTRAL.

LEAGUE CENTRAL WILL NOT PUBLISH OR RELEASE ANY PERSONAL INFORMATION CONTAINED IN ANY SUBSCRIBER WEBSITE.

ALL PLAYERS WILL HAVE LAST YEARS AVERAGE ENTERED INTO LEAGUE CENTRAL TO START OUT THE YEAR THEN THE POWER AVERAGE WILL GO INTO EFFECT. NEW PLAYERS AND PLAYERS GOING FROM B DIVISION TO A DIVISION WILL USE THE LEAGUE AVERAGE. PLAYERS GOING FROM A TO B WILL RETAIN THEIR INDIVIDUAL AVERAGE (28SEPT16). OUR NEW FORMAT LEAGUE CENTRAL CALCULATES A POWER AVERAGE WHICH ELIMINATES THE ABILITY TO SAND BAG. A DIVISION AVERAGE IS 7.33 (7) AND B DIVISION AVERAGE IS 6.12 (6).

WHAT IS “POWER AVERAGE”?

POWER AVERAGE IS THE AVERAGE MARGIN OF POINTS OF WHICH A PLAYER WINS OR LOSES EACH GAME. IT’S CALCULATION: A PLAYER’S TOTAL POINTS FOR ALL GAMES PLAYED MINUS ALL TOTAL POINTS SCORED AGAINST HIM DIVIDED BY THE AMOUNT OF GAMES THAT PLAYER HAS PLAYED. A PLAYER WHO WINS ALL OF HIS GAMES BY A SCORE OF 10-7 WOULD HAVE A POWER AVERAGE OF +3; A PLAYER WHO WINS ALL OF HIS GAMES BY A SCORE OF 10-2 WOULD HAVE A POWER AVERAGE OF +8; IN A NORMAL 10-POINT SYSTEM, BOTH OF THESE PLAYERS WOULD HAVE AVERAGES OF 10.

POWER AVERAGE CAN BE USED TO “WEIGHT” PLAYER AVERAGES, THUS DISTINGUISHING BETWEEN i.e., PLAYERS WHO WINS GAMES BY SCORES OF 10-7 VS. PLAYERS WHO WIN GAMES BY SCORES OF 10-2. A % OF A PLAYER’S POWER AVERAGE (IF A POSITIVE NUMBER) CAN BE ADDED TO HIS REGULAR 10-POINT AVERAGE, THUS INCREASING HIS HANDICAP AVERAGE (THE ONE USED TO DETERMINE TEAM HANDICAP). PLAYERS WITH NEGATIVE POWER AVERAGES ARE NOT ADJUSTED.

EXAMPLE: IF 30% OF A PLAYER’S POWER AVERAGE WERE APPLIED, A PLAYER WHO WINS ALL OF HIS GAMES 10-7 WOULD HAVE A HANDICAP AVERAGE OF 11; A PLAYER WHO WINS ALL OF HIS GAMES 10-2 WOULD HAVE A HANDICAP AVERAGE OF 12. THE CALCULATIONS ARE AS SHOWN:

PLAYER WHO WINS ALL GAMES 10-7

10-POINT AVERAGE (10) + 30% OF POWER AVERAGE (30% X 3.00= .90) = 10.90 WHICH ROUNDS TO 11.

PLAYER WHO WINS ALL GAMES 10-2

10-POINT AVERAGE (10) + 30% OF POWER AVERAGE (30% X 8.00= 2.40) = 12.40 WHICH ROUNDS TO 12. PER LEAGUE PRESIDENT WE WILL USE A POWER AVERAGE CALCULATION OF 50%.

HANDICAPS WILL BE IN EFFECT THE FIRST NIGHT. NEW PLAYERS WILL START WITH THE LEAGUE AVERAGE. STARTING AFTER WEEK 1 WILL HAVE THEIR AVERAGES CALCULATED THAT NIGHT OF PLAY (09/03). NEW PLAYERS ADDED AFTER 11/2/02 MUST HAVE LEAGUE OFFICERS APPROVAL BEFORE THE MATCH OR THEIR SCORES WILL NOT COUNT (09/02). THIS WILL BE ENFORCED!

HOME TEAM WRITES LINE UP DOWN FIRST. PLAYERS MAY BE RANKED IN ANY ORDER, AS ALL PLAYERS WILL PLAY EACH OTHER ONCE. HOME TEAM BREAKS ROUNDS 1 & 3. VISITING TEAM BREAKS ROUNDS 2 & 4.

MARK ERO AND 8 BALL ON BREAK FOR EACH PLAYER. AN ERO IS WHEN THE PLAYER RUNS 7 OBJECT BALLS AND THE 8 BALL ON HIS FIRST ATTEMPT AT THE TABLE WITH 15 BALLS ON THE TABLE. MARK 10-0'S AND 40 TO LOW SCORE TO RECEIVE RECOGNITION.

TEAM CAPTAINS SHOULD READ THE VALLEY (VNEA) RULE BOOK TO FAMILIARIZE THEMSELVES WITH ANY RULE CHANGES OR CLARIFICATIONS. KNOWING THE RULES WILL PREVENT MOST DISAGREEMENTS.

THE LEAGUE HAS 1 VALLEY CERTIFIED REFEREES AT THIS TIME TO CONTACT IN ANY RULE DISAGREEMENT: LYLE JOHNSTON 218-780-3025 (POPPERS).

RULE CHANGES

- ✓ OUR LEAGUE HAS CUE BALL FOULS ONLY. OBJECT BALLS ARE REPOSITIONED. ANY MOVED BALL CONTACTING CUE BALL, OR ANY MOVED BALL CAUSING A BALL TO BE JUMPED OR POCKETED.
- ✓ IF THERE IS A QUESTIONABLE FOUL DURING LEAGUE PLAY WITH NO AGREEMENT-RE-RACK.
- ✓ JUMP SHOTS ARE ALLOWED-CUE MUST BE AT LEAST A 45-DEGREE ANGLE.
- ✓ MAKING THE 8 ON THE BREAK THE BREAKER CAN EITHER HAVE THE 8 BALL SPOTTED AND CONTINUE SHOOTING OR ASK FOR A RE-RACK AND BREAK AGAIN.
- ✓ AS THE RULE READS- INTENTIONAL FOUL RULE
- ✓ WHEN THE CUE BALL AND OBJECT BALL ARE FROZEN, RULES ON DOUBLE HITS AND PUSH SHOT FOULS COME INTO PLAY (PG 24 #6 & #7).
- ✓ IF GAMES ARE PLAYED OUT OF TURN, THEY WILL BE SCORED IN THE ROUND THE 2 PLAYERS WOULD HAVE PLAYED. (1/03)
- ✓ THE ABSENT PLAYER RECEIVES 4 POINTS (16 TOTAL) --OPPONENT-36 POINTS IN THE REGULAR SEASON AND \$ TOURNAMENT (09/97).
- ✓ TEAM MATCH GRACE PERIOD IS 30 MINUTES.
- ✓ 16 GAME ROTATION FORMAT AS IMPLEMENTED IN (9-02).
- ✓ TEAMS MUST PLAY ON A 7 FT TABLE IF IT IS AVAILABLE (9/98)
- ✓ MATCHES MUST BE PLAYED AT CURRENT LEAGUE SITES WHEN HOME TABLE IS NOT AVAILABLE- HOME CAPTAIN DECIDES SITE. (9/03)
- ✓ WHEN A SUB PLAYER SHOOTS 1 NIGHT FOR 1 TEAM, HE IS ASSIGNED TO THAT TEAM ONLY (10-96).
- ✓ PLAYERS MUST SHOOT 65% OF REGULAR SEASON TO BE IN YEAR END AWARDS.

- ✓ IF A TEAM DROPS OUT AFTER THE FIRST WEEK OF PLAY, ALL TEAMS WILL RECEIVE THE HIGHEST SCORE SHOT AGAINST THAT TEAM-RETROACTIVE TO ALL THE TEAMS BACK TO THE 1ST WEEK (ALL TEAMS RECEIVE THE HIGHEST POINTS SHOT). A BYE IS 128 POINTS.
- ✓ AFTER INITIAL ROSTER IS GIVEN AND TEAMS ARE SLOTTED INTO DIVISIONS, THE NEW PLAYERS CAN ONLY PLAY DOWN ONE DIVISION LOWER THAN LAST YEARS DIVISION.
- ✓ 51 % OF CAPTAINS MUST BE PRESENT TO AMEND RULES AT CAPTAIN MEETINGS.
- ✓ LEAGUE CHECKS ARE VOID AFTER 90 DAYS.
- ✓ SECRETARY FEE IS SET AT \$45.00 PER TEAM. PRES, VICE PRES. WILL NO LONGER BE PAID POSITIONS.
- ✓ LEAGUE FEE RAISED FOR ALL TEAMS TO \$10.00 PER PLAYER (09/16 CAPT. MTG. REVISED)
- ✓ A&B HIGH SHOOTER AWARDS FOR INDIVIDUAL 1ST, 2ND, 3RD PLACE.
- ✓ MINN PASTIME WILL MAIL CAPTAINS MEETING NOTICES TO CAPTAINS.
- ✓ PASTIME WILL RECEIVE CHECKING ACCOUNT STATEMENTS. SECRETARY WILL RECEIVE COPY FOR RECORDS. (09/99).
- ✓ THE LEAGUE WILL SANCTION A DIVISION TEAMS – THIS WILL NOT COVER THE EVELETH LEAGUE FOR VNEA (9-18-17)

 REPLACEMENT OF E.C. MEMBER WILL CONSIST OF A 2/3 VOTE OF THE DIVISION TO MAKE A CHANGE.
 OPEN TOURNAMENT FOR STATE TEAM AND SINGLES TOURNAMENTS.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE RULES AMENDMENTS 1996-1997

ANY PLAYER WHO HAS NOT PLAYED ON YOUR TEAM BY DEC. 1 MUST HAVE LEAGUE OFFICER APPROVAL. WHEN A PLAYER IS LISTED ON A TEAM ROSTER AS A REGULAR OR A SUB PLAYER, HE IS CONSIDERED TO BE A PLAYER ON THAT TEAM. TEAM PLAYERS CANNOT SHOOT FOR ANOTHER TEAM UNLESS THE PLAYER IS SWITCHING TEAMS PERMANENTLY OR THE PLAYER WILL BE A LEAGUE SUB, WHICH WILL REQUIRE LEAGUE OFFICER APPROVAL BEFORE ANY MATCHES ARE PLAYED. IF A TEAM PLAYER SHOOTS FOR ANOTHER TEAM, HIS POINTS ARE INVALID FOR THAT MATCH AND IF THERE IS A PROTEST FILED, THE INELIGIBLE PLAYERS WILL BE FINED A 10 POINT DEDUCTION FOR THAT MATCH.

IF A PLAYER IS NOT LISTED ON A TEAM ROSTER AND PLAYS FOR A TEAM ONE TIME, HE IS CONSIDERED TO BE A PLAYER ON THAT TEAM.

ADDITIONAL RULE CHANGES

A PLAYER MAY NOT TRANSFER TO ANOTHER TEAM EXCEPT BY APPROVAL OF THE LEAGUE COMMITTEE AND OFFICERS. TRANSFERS ARE NORMALLY ONLY ALLOWED IN CASES WHERE A TEAM HAS DROPPED OUT OF THE LEAGUE. SHOULD A TRANSFER BE APPROVED, THE PLAYER TRANSFERRING MUST BEGIN WITH A ZERO AVERAGE ON THE NEW TEAM. IT IS NOT POSSIBLE TO TRANSFER POINTS EARNED ON ONE TEAM TO ANOTHER.

IF YOU ARE ADDING OR DROPPING A PLAYER AT ANY TIME, SEND A NOTE ALONG WITH THE SCORE SHEET INFORMING THE SECRETARY OF THE CHANGE. YOU MUST ENCLOSE THE ADDRESS AND PHONE NUMBER AND EMAIL ADDRESS OF ANY NEW PLAYER, SO THAT THIS INFORMATION CAN BE TRANSFERRED TO THE ROSTER.

IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PLAY IN THE MONEY TOURNAMENT AT THE END OF THE YEAR, YOU MUST HAVE PLAYED AT LEAST **3 NIGHTS OR 12 GAMES**. BEFORE THE MONEY TOURNAMENT IS HELD. A SHEET WILL BE SENT OUT LISTING ALL ELIGIBLE PLAYERS, NO EXCEPTIONS! (02/98 EXEC. COMM.).

IF THERE IS A TIE DURING THE MONEY TOURNAMENT IN POINTS, EACH TEAM WILL CHOOSE ONE PLAYER TO HAVE A ONE GAME PLAYOFF MATCH TO DETERMINE THE WINNING TEAM, TOTAL 10'S WILL NOT COUNT (SUDDEN DEATH CLAUSE).

UNSPORTSMAN LIKE CONDUCT

FIRST TIME -- WARNING FROM PLAYER.

SECOND TIME -- STOP MATCH AND CALL PRESIDENT -- CALL VICE PRESIDENT IF PRESIDENT NOT AVAILABLE, AS PER PRESIDENT'S (OR VICE PRESIDENT'S IF PRESIDENT IS UNAVAILABLE) DECISION THE PLAYER IS DONE PLAYING FOR THE NIGHT, NO REPLACEMENT. TAKE ALL POINTS AWAY FROM PLAYER.

IF A SECOND INFRACTION OCCURS, AND THE PLAYER IS FOUND GUILTY OF UNSPORTSMAN LIKE CONDUCT, HE WILL BE BANNED FROM THE LEAGUE FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE SEASON.

WHEN A SHOOTER IS SHOOTING, THE OPPOSING PLAYER MUST STAND OFF TO THE SIDE AND CANNOT BE IN LINE WITH THE POCKET. IF NEEDED, CALL A REFEREE.
